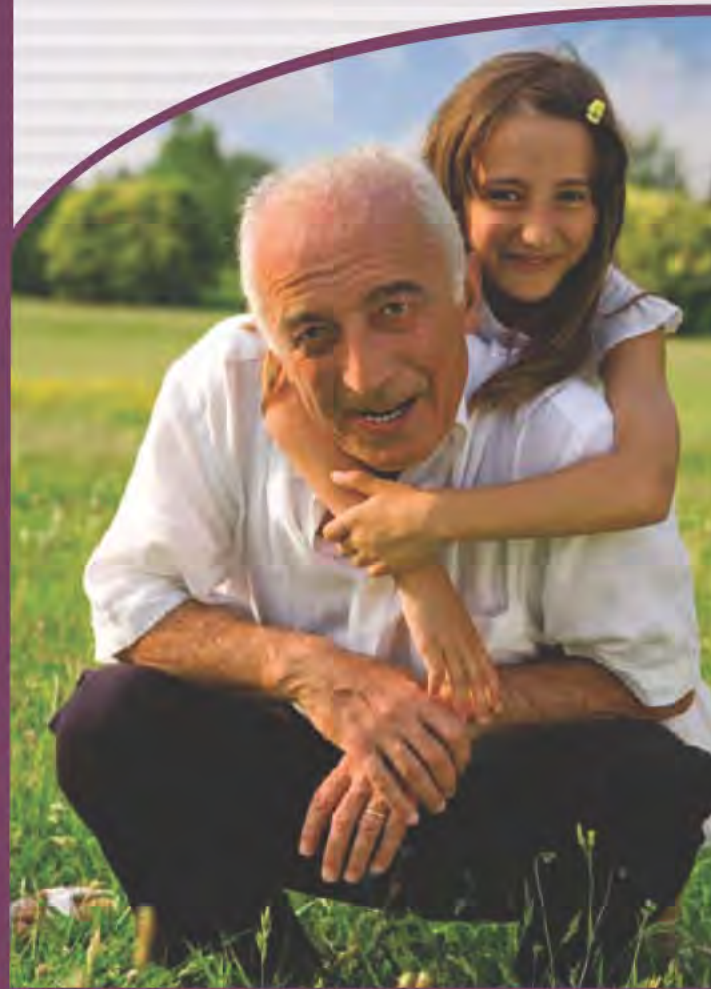

RIKC provides neuropsychological and rehabilitation psychology services in order to best serve individuals of all ages who have experienced conditions such as:

- Brain injury or concussion
- Stroke
- Brain tumor
- Multiple Sclerosis, Parkinson's, and other progressive neurological diseases
- Alzheimer's and other Dementia Disorders
- Developmental and Congenital Disorders
- Learning Disorder
- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder

- Spina Bifida
- Chronic Pain Disorders
- Multiple Trauma
- Limb Loss



HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

Upon referral, neuropsychology staff will verify your insurance coverage on your behalf for the service requested.

Neuropsychological Assessment

An initial interview will be scheduled to discuss any questions or concerns you may have regarding the assessment. Following this interview, an assessment session will be scheduled based on referral question and patient needs. The neuropsychologist will explain limits of confidentiality and the nature and purpose of testing. You will be offered an opportunity to schedule a feedback session where the neuropsychologist will review findings and recommendations.

Rehabilitation Counseling

An initial interview will be scheduled for an intake counseling meeting with a psychologist to discuss goals for counseling and questions you may have regarding counseling sessions. The psychologist will discuss confidentiality and the nature and purpose of counseling. Based on your needs, you and the psychologist will develop and schedule sessions of 20 to 45 minutes in length. The number of counseling sessions varies depending on individual needs.
