About Ability KC and Day at the Lake

Ability KC brings together Rehabilitation Institute of Kansas City and Children's Therapeutic Learning Center. Annually, 2,700 individuals and families receive services for medical rehabilitation, therapeutic preschool and employment services. In addition, multiple specialty programs and services are offered, such as neuropsychology and rehabilitation psychology, applied behavior analysis (ABA), corporate partnerships for employment opportunities and much more. Ability KC is proud to celebrate 70 years since the beginning of each agency in 1947. Thousands of lives have been changed and celebrations of successes have occurred due to the generosity of the Kansas City community.

A Day at the Lake is an adaptive water sports clinic providing individuals living with paralysis or amputation the chance to experience the freedom and exhilaration of being on the water. Rehabilitation professionals team up with community volunteers to offer adaptive waterskiing, boat rides and water sports. The event is provided FREE and is open to individuals 16 or older with spinal cord injury/disease or amputation. The event is in its 23rd year and averages 60 participants. Personal Watercraft Uses

- Personal watercraft must be able to accommodate 3 riders.
- Serve as "Chase Drivers" following boats pulling water skiers. Chase Drivers will be accompanied by a trained volunteer who will assist skiers and address their safety in the water.

Volunteer Commitment

- Provide & Drive Personal Watercraft (PWC) that is in good working condition.
- Be 21 years of age or older.
- Be a skilled PWC driver with good judgment.
- Provide proof of PWC licensing.
- Bring your own life jacket/vest.
- Abide by the safety guidelines and instructions of event organizers.
- All water-related volunteers are required to attend a Volunteer Training Session prior to event – Saturday, June 10, 2017 at Smithville Lake.

Ability KC Commitment

- Provide event liability insurance coverage (in case of personal injury to participants or volunteers).
- Pair PWC Volunteers with trained event volunteers.
- Provide FREE refueling of PWC during the event (at Camp Branch Marina).
- Provide on-site staff oversight at event.
- Provide lunch to volunteers.
